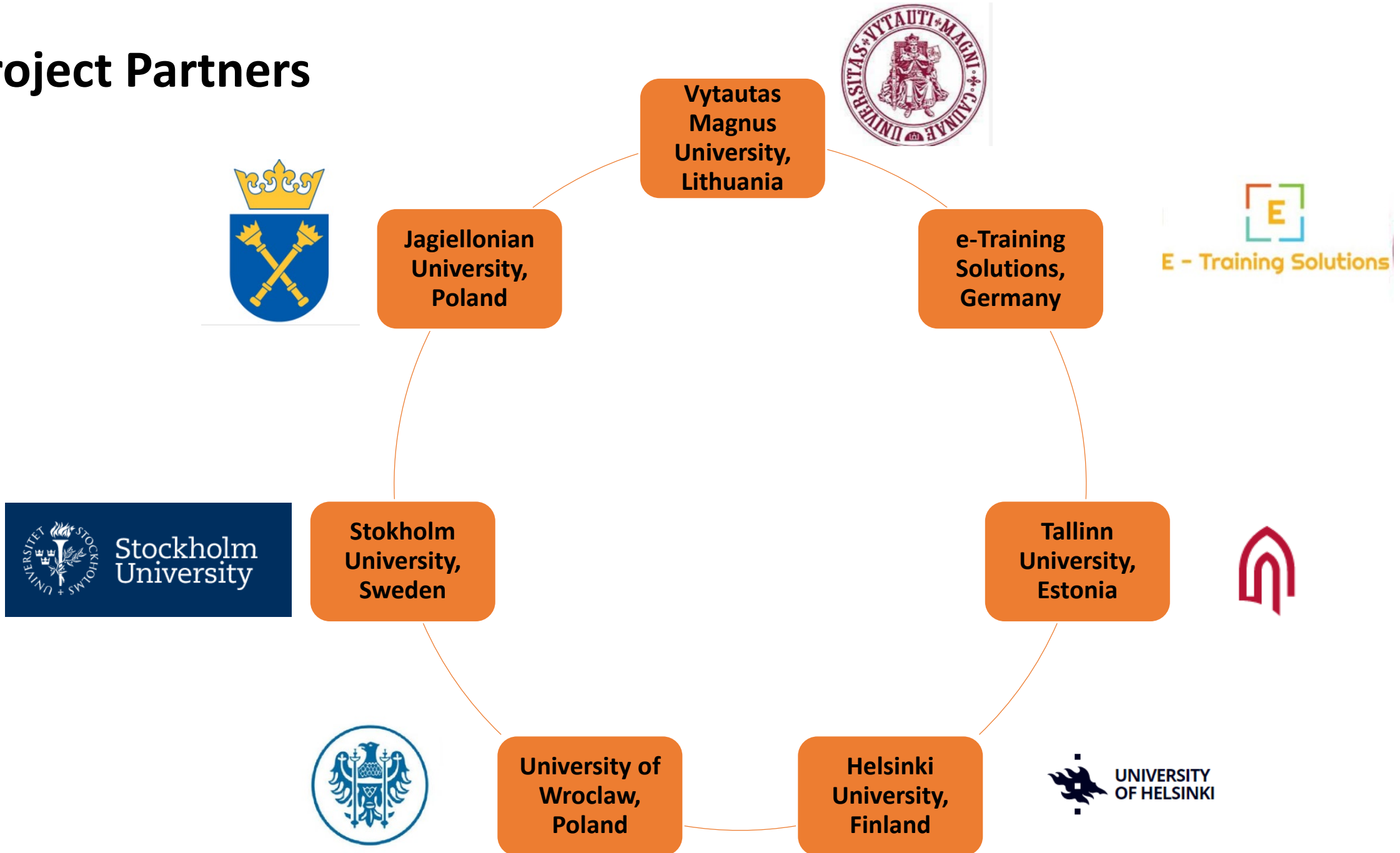


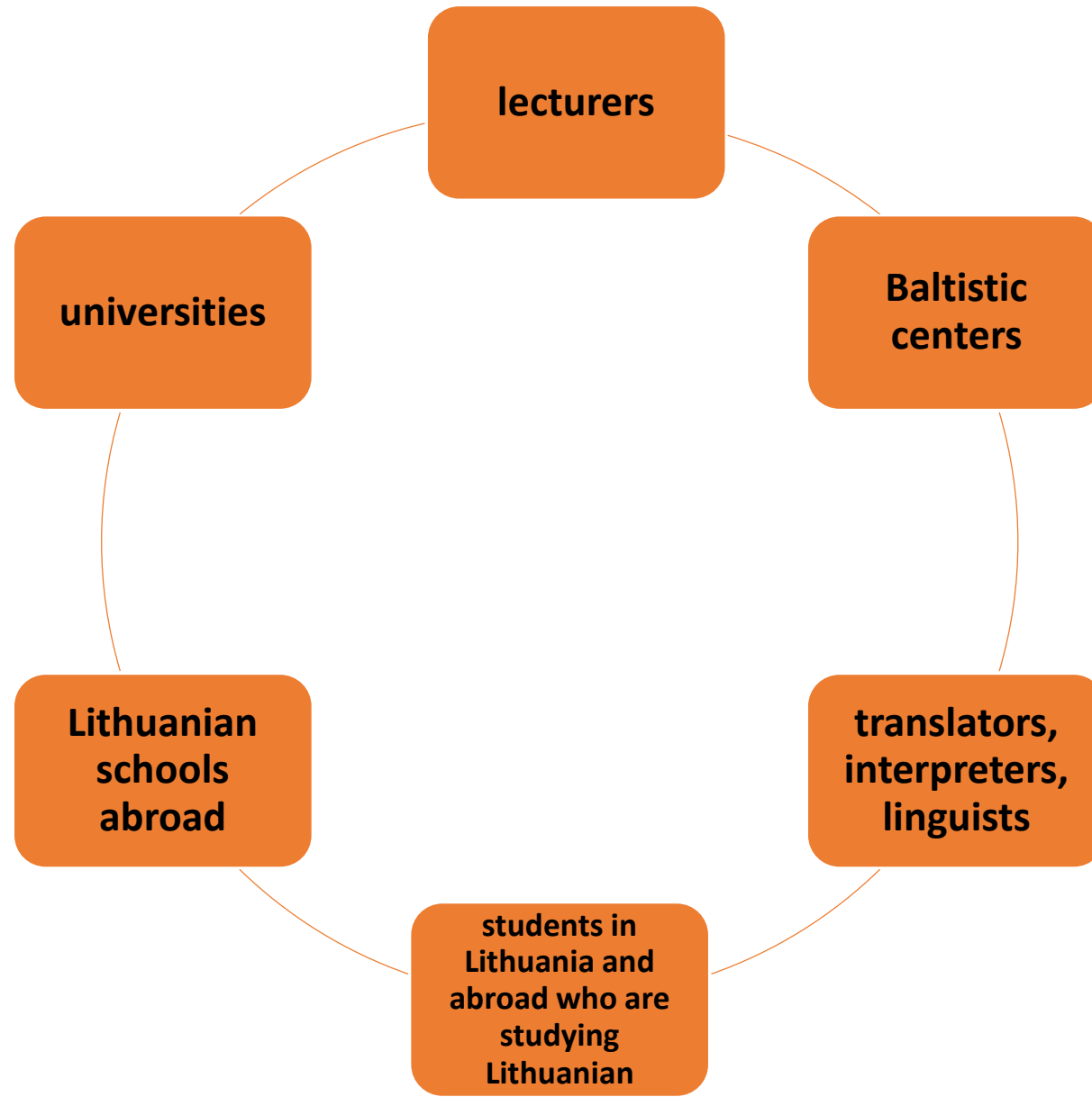

- **Finalise IO1 (Tallinn)** - focus on adapting methodology for digital training, assessment and recognition of learning outcomes gained through online course; more info in the application

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Workplan for 2022 I quarter (Jan-Mar)



- **Finalise IO2 (Wroclaw)** - mapping the most suitable digital training tools (IO2) + **webinar presentation**.

Workplan for 2022 I quarter (Jan-Mar)



- **[continuous] developing open educational resources for Lithuanian language (IO3) and culture (IO4) training:**
Lithuanian language AND culture training programme online, awarded with 6 ECTS for 140 hours of contact (digitally) and individual work during the 4 weeks course

Workplan for 2022 I quarter (Jan-Mar)



- **launching an online student-teacher-mentor collaboration platform (IO5)** – innovative open online education and student-teacher-mentor collaboration platform for delivering the training course(s), allowing managing the participants, their schedules, progress and achievements.

II quarter (Apr-Jun)



- **Baltic forum (Wroclaw, Poland)** of 2022 will be dedicated specifically to the diLILAC project and invite the target groups of Lithuanian language and culture educators for an open discussion. Almost 150 participants, with the majority being foreigners to the host country, will be presented with the almost-finished intellectual outputs of the project.

- **Pilot in real environment during the Baltic Summer University of 2022**
 - questionnaire for impact assessment (see application)
 - Number of registered users on the platform by the end of the project – 300
 - Involve 100 participants with fewer opportunities:
Cultural differences; Economic obstacles;
Geographical obstacles; Disability; Health problems;
Educational difficulties

IV quarter (Oct-Dec)

- **develop guidelines on virtual mentoring (IO6)** which will facilitate the work of mentors and programme administrators

- **Second pilot during Intensive LCC Winter Courses of 2023**
